ON THIS DAY: 31st JANUARY

31st January

1874

It was 146 years ago today! The St. Helens Standard carried a report of Saints' very first match, against Liverpool Royal Infirmary, at Boundary Road. Details of the score and scorers is rather sketchy, to say the least, but, according to the paper: "On no side being called the Liverpool men had added another touchdown to their score, a very pleasant game thus terminating in a draw in their favour". Club Founder William Douglas Herman captained the team from full-back.

1981

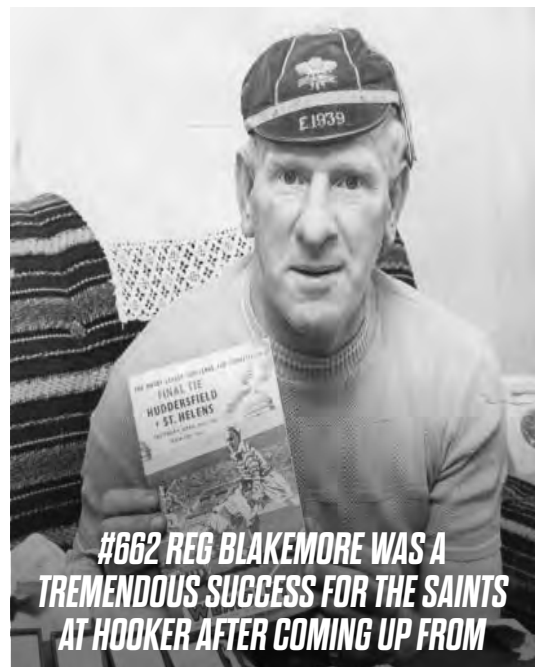
European Championship: France 35 Wales 5 at Stade de l'Égassiaral, Narbonne. Bustling front-rower Roger Owen made his Welsh debut and replaced fellow Saint Mel James from the bench. Clive Griffiths was the other replacement, with Roy Mathias at loose forward.

2003

Saints were beaten 39-41 by Sale Sharks in a 'cross-code challenge' match at Knowsley Road. The visitors from the 15-a-side code won the first half under union rules 41-0. The second half of rugby league saw Saints score 39 points without reply doing what they did best. It was certainly not a 'point-less' exercise in the literal sense and was arguably more interesting than the usual 'friendly' clash. Yet it emphasised the technically different aspects of the two codes.

How about this for a team of Saints' Welsh imports, complete with their Heritage Numbers, who all joined from the rugby union code in the Principality? It could take on all-comers!

A WELCOME TO SALFORD RED DEVILS

The Super League fixture planners have certainly given us a wonderful treat this evening as we open our 2020 campaign with a visit from last season's Super League Grand Finalists, Salford Red Devils.

Salford had a magnificent 2019 campaign. A 'Middle 8' contender in 2018, they absolutely astounded everyone last year, by not only finishing in 3rd position, but, by reaching their first ever Super League Grand Final. It really was the 'stuff of dreams' that almost became one of Super League's truly great stories.

So in 2020, head coach, Ian Watson has to follow that. And that is most certainly going to be easier said than done. Salford knew mid-season, when they were only mid-table, that several of their higher profile players were going to leave the club at the end of 2019 and as the season progressed, somehow, Watson managed to shut out all of the off the field distractions to build momentum in his squad to peak at exactly the right time. But of course having reached the Grand Final, he is now left with having to put a new squad of players together to compete in Super League XXV. Since the start of the season, Bevan French (Parramatta Eels) joined the club whilst, Josh Ganson (Widnes Vikings), Liam Forsyth (Leigh Centurions), Liam Paisley (Barrow Raiders), Taulima Tautai (released) and Morgan Escare (Wakefield Trinity – on loan) have departed.

His most notable departure is of course, Steve Prescott 'Man of Steel', Jackson Hastings, an ever present last year, who has, along with Jake Bibby joined Wigan Warriors. Hull FC bound Josh Jones; Josh Griffin who has signed for Castleford Tigers and Logan Tomkins (Widnes Vikings) are three more of the other ten players

who have also left the club. The question now on everyone's lips is whether his new recruits can fill these players' boots and help replicate the form that Salford showed for much of last year.

The key recruit is of course is Kevin Brown from Warrington Wolves. He is now 35 and missed almost the whole of 2019 after suffering an Achilles tendon injury last January. An England International and World Cup Finalist just three years ago, Brown has an outstanding pedigree and how he settles in with his new club and what sort of partnership he can strike up with Tui Lolohea will go a long way in determining whether the Red Devils will emulate last season's achievements.

Other notable recruits include, former Super League Dream Team, player Sebastine Ikahihifo from Huddersfield Giants, Dan Sarginson (Wigan Warriors) and Luke Yates (London Broncos). They are just three of Salford's other eight new signings.

Salford have faced Saints on forty six occasions since the onset of Super League. Saints have won forty of these previous Super League meetings between the sides, including all fourteen matches played at Knowsley Road, one at the Stobart Stadium and eight at the Totally Wicked Stadium; including the Grand Opening game in 2012. In this period, St. Helens have also defeated Salford 23-6 in last season's Super League Grand Final and have won each of the three Challenge Cup ties between the two teams. For the record, St. Helens have won their last 35 home matches versus the Red Devils. Salford's last win in St. Helens was, 40 years ago, by 18 points to 17 back on the 12th January, 1980.

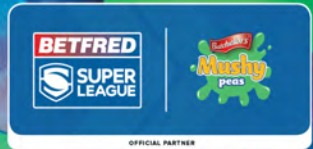

Fixture Change!

Toronto Wolfpack have confirmed that our Round 5 Betfred Super League clash as part of the '2020 London Series' has had to be relocated to Warrington Wolves' Halliwell Jones Stadium.

The fixture on Saturday 29 February was due to take place at Saracens Allianz Park with kick off at 6pm, but the change has unfortunately been forced upon the Wolfpack after significant changes were made to the agreed terms and conditions of the original agreed fixture at Saracens. The date and kick off time will remain unchanged

Martin Vickers UK General Manager said: "It is with great disappointment that we need to make this change, but sadly it comes as a result of reasons outside of our control.

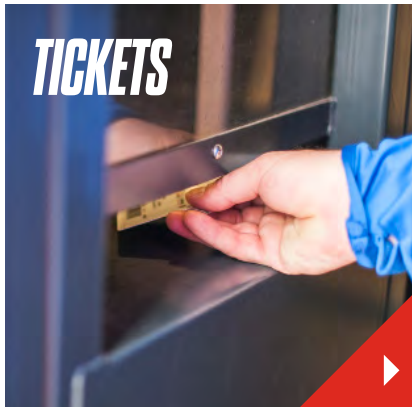

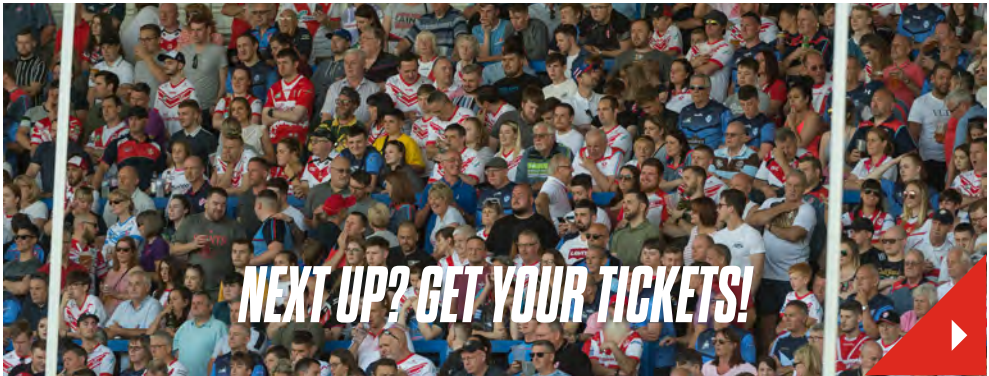
