VIEW FROM THE CLUB...



Your last game before your injury was the Grand Final; what kind of experience was that for you?

It was amazing – it's the thing you dream of doing when you're a kid. To get the chance; it was even more special after the year we had, we walked away with it and then deservedly won. To score made it that extra little bit special!

You then went on to have off season surgery on your shoulder, what was the recovery process like?

It was tough. I got both my shoulders done at the same time, because it meant that I'd definitely be back then for the World Club Challenge, so that's what I decided to do. I didn't want to miss the World Club Challenge, so I put myself through that which was tough, obviously my Mrs had to do a lot for me - I was very reliant on her, so it was difficult!

How difficult was it having to sit on the side line for the very start of the season?

It's tough; it's a mental challenge more than a physical one I think when you're out injured. Every week seems the same, you're surrounded by the same walls in the gym while the boys are out there, you feel a bit like you're getting left behind. It is very frustrating.

It was clear in the Warrington loss we were missing that physicality down the middle – you've come in and made a huge impact, how does it feel getting back into the team?

It's great to be back. Obviously back for the Hull game and the World Club Challenge – and we've had some wins and I think in general we have been good. On another day in that WCC, we take those opportunities and it's a different game. We weren't that far off at all really, which is pleasing given that they're the best club team in the world. I thought for big periods we were the better team; I think they probably just taught us a lesson on being clinical and taking your opportunities.

How difficult do you think the match vs the Giants tonight will be?

They've started well. They've definitely got some confidence and they've played a few games back to back. They'll definitely fancy themselves; they had that slip up against Wigan but the best way for them to rectify it would be beating us, the reigning Champions on Friday.

THE BIRTHPLACE OF RUGBY LEAGUE HUDDERSFIELD GIANTS 1835

A WELCOME TO... HUDDERSFIELD GIANTS

The Giants arrive with a spring in their step having won their opening three away matches in 2020.

In fact, despite having a game in hand on the leading two clubs in Super League, Huddersfield are lying in 4th place on the league ladder, level on points, and just two places behind the Saints.

Huddersfield were competitive for much of last year's campaign; but a series of injuries and a loss of confidence and form mid-season saw them slip down the table; eventually only avoiding relegation by defeating the Catalans Dragons, at home, by 24 points to 22 on the last day of the season. After breathing a huge sigh of relief, following their dramatic survival, head coach, Simon Woolford was able to assess their efforts and build for 2020.

Huddersfield have avoided the temptation to panic and have recruited well; with Ashton Golding (Leeds Rhinos), Aidan Sezer (Canberra Raiders, Aus), James Gavet (Newcastle Knights, Aus), Kenny Edwards (Catalans Dragons, Fra) and Owen Trout (Leeds Rhinos) joining the club.

Sezer is an outstanding half back. He is the Giants Marquee signing and having helped the Canberra Raiders reach last year's NRL Grand Final, is a most exciting acquisition. Gavet and Edwards are two further quality recruits who add leadership and experience to the Huddersfield ranks.

Matt Frawley (Canberra Raiders, Aus), Kruise Leeming & Alex Mellor (both Leeds Rhinos), Dale Ferguson (Featherstone Rovers), Colton Roche (Bradford Bulls), Sebastine Ikahihifo (Salford Red Devils), Izaac Farrell (Sheffield Eagles) and Scott Grix (Halifax) have each departed.

Huddersfield won their three warm up matches, defeating, Halifax (H) 42-6, Wakefield Trinity (A) 16-4 and Batley Bulldogs (A) 26-22. They began their Super League campaign in great form and caused quite a stir in defeating Catalans Dragons (A) 32-12, last year's Super League Grand Finalists, Salford Red Devils (A) 12-10 and Hull KR (A) 22-4, to top the table after four rounds. Last Sunday, they suffered a setback, following a 10-42 loss at home to Wigan Warriors; but, after five rounds, there is still an air of confidence in the Giants' camp; although they know tonight they face their ultimate challenge as they visit the Saints, last year's Champions.

St. Helens have faced Huddersfield on 51 occasions in the Super League. Saints have won 38 of them and there has been one draw. In 2013 the Giants' completed their first league 'double' over Saints in 62 years. They also defeated St. Helens in a 'Magic' match at Newcastle in 2016. Seven of their other nine victories over Saints were at the John Smiths Stadium with their only other 'away' wins being in the Super 8s in both 2015 and 2018. St. Helens defeated Huddersfield 15-2 in the 2009 Play Offs and have also won six of the seven Challenge Cup meetings between the two teams during this period; including a 46-6 Semi Final triumph at Warrington in 2004 and a 42-12 Final victory at Twickenham in 2006. The Giants sole Cup win was their 24-14 Semi Final triumph in 2009, also played at Warrington.

AIDEN SEZER Half Back

After making 155 NRL appearances, Sezer became Huddersfield's Marquee signing. Sezer became a key figure at the Gold Coast Titans before signing for Canberra in 2016. Being of Turkish descent, he played for Turkey in 2018 before leading Canberra to their first NRL final in over 2 decades, in 2019!



JAMES GAVET FRONT ROW

Gavet made his debut in 2012 for Canterbury Bulldogs. Since then he has had spells with West Tigers, Brisbane Broncos, New Zealand Warriors and Newcastle Knights, making 75 NRL appearances. Gavet has represented Samoa on four occasions and in 2020, he will look to crack the Super League for the first time.



JORDAN TURNER CENTRE

After a short stint with Canberra Raiders, Turner signed for Huddersfield in 2017. A Grand Final winner with St. Helens, he was part of the side that became 2014 Super League Champions. He has over 300 career appearances to his name with an abundance of experience on both sides of the world.

JERMAINE MCGILLVARY WINGER

Debuting for the Giants in 2010 against Bradford Bulls, McGillivary has over 300 career appearances to his name. Between 2013 and 2017 McGillivary scored 20 tries a season, and in 2015, he was the Super League's top try scorer and was named in the Super League Dream Team, before top scoring for England in the 2017 RLWC.

UKUMA TA'AI BACK ROW/PROP

Ta'ai has made over 200 career appearance in the NRL and Super League. After starting his career with the New Zealand Warriors, he signed for the Giants in 2013. Internationally he has made 10 appearances for his native Tonga and is an explosive, powerful forward.

VIEW FROM THE OPPOSITION!

Paul Clough still lives in St Helens and travels with Lee Gaskell from the town to Huddersfield every day. We caught up with the former Saint on life at the Giants...

Cloughy, welcome back! How are you feeling ahead of facing your old side?

It won't be the first time I have played St.Helens having probably played 7 or 8 times now since I left, but it's great to be back at a great stadium and play in front of a great crowd. Saints are the best team in the league and it will be great to see some old faces and I am looking forward to tonight's game.

Is it difficult playing against your former team?

I try and treat it like any other game. Most of my time was at Knowsley Road, but I still keep in touch with a few lads, the likes of Robes, Jonny, Wello, Nathan Mill (Physio) and Matty Daniels (Strength & Conditioning) and see them around town in coffee shops!

Did you watch the World Club Challenge game the other week?

Yes I did. A few calls could have gone Saints' way and it shows how good they are. Saints really did compete and it was good to see Robes back playing again and Big Al was the best forward on the park in my opinion. Saints were entertaining to watch and showed they can compete with that level.

The Giants have had a great start to the year...

Super League is a marathon, not a sprint. It is good to get some wins under the belt early doors. We had a great pre-season, but it is not going to be easy throughout the year as it is a long hard season. Games against Wigan last week are not going to be easy and yes we have had a good start, but we aren't going to get carried away. Hopefully we can be towards the top of the table rather than the bottom!

How is life under Simon Woolford?

He is great to work with and certainly helped my game. We have had some great coaches here and we are a tight knit group. It is a good group to be a part of and I am just really grateful Huddersfield gave me the lifeline to get my Super League career back on track, bringing me over from the Championship. I am really thankful to them.

What are you expecting tonight?

Saints play a really tough brand of rugby and like to throw the ball around. They challenge you all over the park and Jonny Lomax is playing the best rugby of his life. A lot of things come off the back of his work. There are 6 or 7 internationals in the team and mixed with NRL experience and wave of Academy talent so it's going to be tough but these are the sort of challenges why you play the game. You want to play against the best and Saints are certainly that.

Northern Rugby League: St. Helens 2 Swinton 6 at Knowsley Road. Scrumhalf and former Parr Central pupil Harold Briscoe made his senior debut three weeks short of his sixteenth birthday. He was born on 27th March 1921 and remains the youngest-ever Saints debutant. Welshman Stan Powell, aged 20, was his stand-off in the match.

1965


Winger Les Quirk was born in Ulverston. Les scored 98 tries in 160 appearances and played in 4 major finals, winning just one – a great pity. He was a superb winger on his day, no question about that. He cemented his place in the first team with a brilliant-hat-trick against Auckland at Knowsley Road on 1st November 1987. Ironically, he never scored four in a match for the Saints.

2015

Super League XX Round 4: Wakefield Trinity Wildcats [6] 16 St Helens [12] 20 at Belle Vue. It is never easy over in Wakefield and Saints won a tight contest courtesy of tries from Jordan Turner, Joe Greenwood and Paul Wellens, playing in the stand-off role. Tommy Makinson kicked 3 goals; Mark Percival also booted over a two-pointer.
