James Graham could make his return debut as a Saint on Sunday, almost nine years since bowing out in 2011.

And ahead of the game we caught up with 'Jammer' to reflect on his return to the Club.

How does it feel to be back?

It's really exciting, but it is a pretty strange experience too. I watched the Totally Wicked Stadium get built and to finally be here and to see it, is pretty special for me. It's a lot different to Knowsley Road and I am really looking forward to playing here and all being well with the fans. It is something I have missed, and I am really excited about that.

How have you been getting on with your new (and some old) teammates?

I know about half of them from being around the traps and some from before I left and there are some new faces as well. But with rugby lads they are always good lads! There has been no distractions in the group. Everyone has come back in tip-top shape so credit to all the players and we are looking forward to today's game!



How has Kristian Woolf helped you since you came back?

Kristian is an amazing coach and his record at Tonga speaks for itself. When you get one win against one of the top teams you can maybe look at it as a one off, but he has beaten all the top three teams in the world and that is no accident. He has got his chance with us here at Saints to be a Head Coach and speaking to him, I love his passion, enthusiasm and will to win and I am looking forward to working with him.

How are you feeling fitness wise?

I am feeling pretty good! I couldn't do too much in quarantine, but it is great to be back and hopefully I am good to go against Catalans – so far so good!

How special will it be to play in front of the Saints fans again?

It really will be. I think when I was first playing here I probably took it for granted. I loved my time in Australia but the one thing they don't have is the singing of songs and stuff like that. I know when I hear 'You fill up my senses' it will be hard to put into words how I will feel. When we are back in front of fans who are singing, it will be special and will mean a hell of a lot to me.

OPPOSITION

A WELCOME TO... CATALANS DRAGONS



Following an enforced suspension, due to the Covid-19 Pandemic; lasting 20 long weeks, Super League rugby returns this afternoon, as Saints face the Catalans Dragons. Reigning Champions, St. Helens participated in the final Super League fixture, way back on 15 March, when they were defeated at Castleford, so it is only fitting that our rearranged Round 4 fixture against the Dragons opens phase two of the 2020 campaign.

The Catalans have only played four matches in 2020 and yet they lie in 5th position on the Super League ladder; three places higher than St. Helens. They currently have six points and are just two points adrift of the early pace setters, Wigan Warriors, Castleford Tigers and Huddersfield Giants and have games in hand on each.

In 2019, the Dragons lacked consistency. After a strong start, they briefly climbed to 3rd position on the league ladder and enjoyed memorable victories over Warrington, St. Helens, Castleford and Wigan. But, they then suffered a loss of form that saw them win just four of their final 14 matches, to slip out of the play off places and to eventually finish seventh.

They began the season with a fine 22 points to 10 'friendly' victory over Toulouse Olympique at the Stade Albert Domec. They were defeated at 'home' by Huddersfield Giants 12-32 in their Super League opener, prior to their visit to Wakefield Trinity being postponed due to adverse weather. The Catalans defeated Castleford Tigers 36-18, back in Perpignan ahead of their week's rest because of Saints' involvement in the World Club Challenge. Successive wins at Hull FC 34-29 and at 'home' over Salford Red Devils 30-14 saw the Dragons climb to 5th position in the league and that's

where they stayed following the postponement of their fixture against Leeds Rhinos ahead of Super League's suspension.

With no rugby played for over four months it's difficult to call the outcome of this afternoon's match. It's going to seem strange playing at a neutral venue in front of no supporters, under the new refined rules, but we are playing rugby again and there is enough talent on show to produce an excellent spectacle to those watching the match on television.



Since their introduction into Super League in 2006, St. Helens have played host to the Dragons on 18 occasions. Saints have won 13 of these matches. At The Totally Wicked Stadium, the Catalans triumphed on their first two visits; in 2012 and 2013 and again early in 2017. At Knowsley Road, St. Helens won five of their seven encounters including victory in two Challenge Cup ties.

ISRAEL FOLAU

Israel Folau joined Catalans earlier this season after joining the club from Australia RU. He began his NRL career at the age of 17 years in Melbourne, becoming the leading try scorer in his first season before signing for Brisbane Broncos. He left rugby league after four years in the NRL, scoring 73 tries in 92 games, and became the youngest player to represent Queensland. He made his international debut with Australia RU and was voted the Wallabies' 'Player of the Year' three times.



JAMES MALONEY

The 34-year-old former Penrith half back has signed with the Dragons for the next three seasons and, in doing so, he became the first Marquee Player in the club's history. James is a World Champion, a two-time NRL winner and has also won the Four Nations and the World Club Challenge; as well as helping NSW win last year's State of Origin series. He was named as the best NRL half back in 2016 and was top points scorer in the NRL in 2013, 2014 and 2015.



SAM KASIANO

Sam, aged 29, joined Catalans from Melbourne Storm. Born in Auckland, he made his 1st Team debut for the Canterbury Bulldogs in 2011 and was selected as the best Prop Forward in the NRL the following year. He joined Melbourne Storm in 2018 and has played for the Kiwis on six occasions including a World Cup final loss to Australia. In 2015 he decided to represent Samoa. Sam has signed for the Dragons until 2021.



JOEL TOMKINS

Captain of Hull KR last season, Joel Tomkins is one of the Dragons' new recruits ahead of the current campaign. The 33-year-old English second row has signed up for two years and joins his brother Sam in Perpignan. He has racked up 227 first team games during his two spells for Wigan Warriors and also played for Saracens RU after briefly switching codes. Powerfully built; but, with excellent handling and footwork skills, he is surprisingly fast for a back-rower.

ON THIS DAY: 2ND AUGUST

1996 Super league round 19: Castleford Tigers 16 St. Helens 20 at Wheldon Road. Anthony Sullivan scored two tries, but the match is best remembered for brilliant cover tackling by Steve Prescott and Joey Hayes when, in the last few seconds, Castleford full-back Jason Flowers looked certain to score and clinch the spoils - and with it, Saints' hopes of an inaugural Super League title! "Desperate situations call for desperate men," said a somewhat relieved Saints' Coach Shaun McRae afterwards. How right he was and the guys were able to celebrate our first major honour of summer rugby league after the last match of the season against Warrington Wolves at Knowsley Road!

1998 Super League round 15: St. Helens 68 Huddersfield Giants 18 at Knowsley Road. Given their recent patchy form before this game, this was a 'must-win' scenario. 3 tries from redoubtable full-back Paul Atcheson took the eye; Sean Long kicked 10 goals, watched by just 4,227 fans, a measure of how the team's recent form had slumped!

2019 Super league round 24: St Helens 26 Wakefield Trinity 6 at the Totally Wicked Stadium. Job done for the Saints in the chase for the League Leader's Shield. Tommy Makinson, Kevin Naiqama and Louie McCarthy-Scarsbrook scored tries; Danny Richardson also scored a four-pointer and kicked five goals in a comfortable victory.

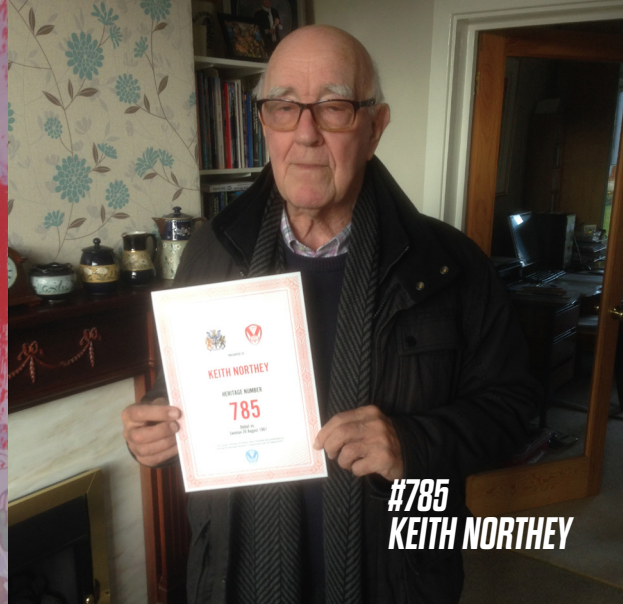

SAINTS' COLLECT HERITAGE NUMBERS...

Former players from the 1960s have collected their Heritage Certificates

#775 Bill Ashall

Bill treasures his one and only senior appearance for the club against Hunslet at Knowsley Road on 20th August 1960. He was part of a front row which also included Abe Terry and hooker Bob Dagnall – all local lads! An engineer by trade, he later moved to Salford.

#785 Keith Northey

Keith was signed from Birkenhead Park RUFC and could play anywhere in the backs and at stand-off if necessary. A stylish footballer, he made 119 appearances for the Saints, winning two Lancashire Cup finals [1963 and 1964], a Western Division Championship [1964] and also played in the 1965 Championship final against Halifax.

#826 Bob Prosser

Another former rugby union signing, [Newport], Bob had superb handling skills and was an early exponent of the now familiar cut-out pass. A valued member of the Saints' 'Four Cups' squad in 1966, he made 45 appearances in the red vee, before later joining Salford, where he was re-united with his former Welsh rugby union stand-off David Watkins. Bob helped to nurture rugby talent as a teacher at Parr High School.

RESERVES LEAGUE TO BE SHELVED FOR 2020

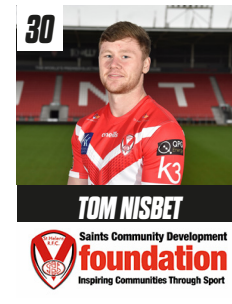
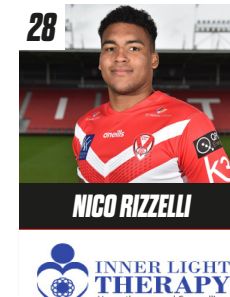
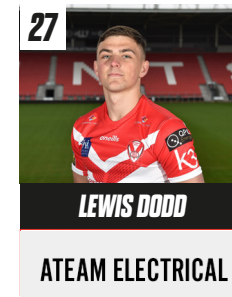
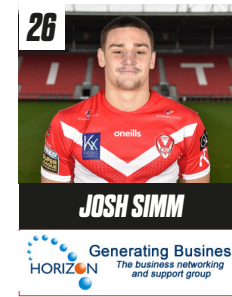
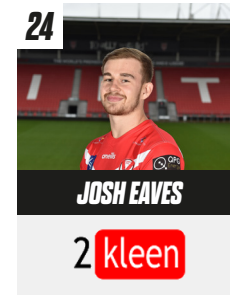
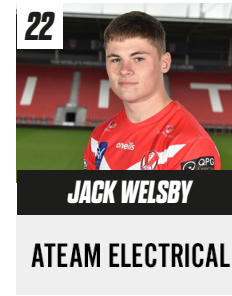
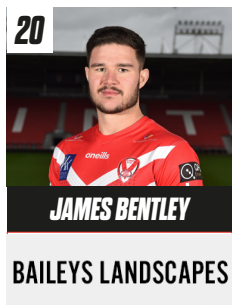
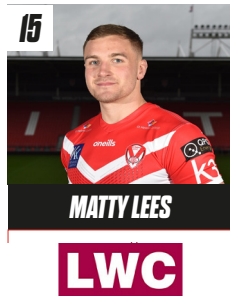
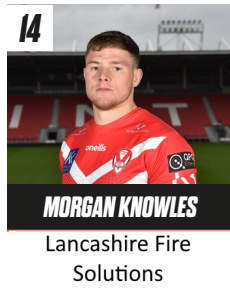
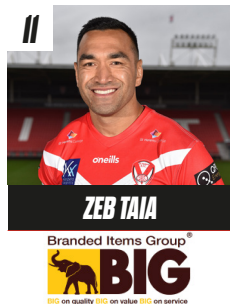
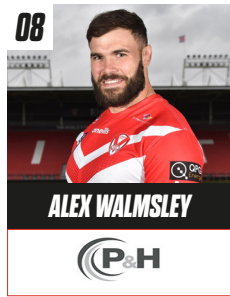
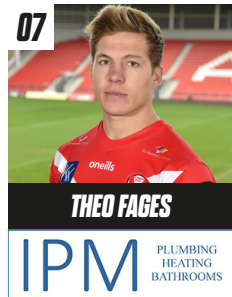
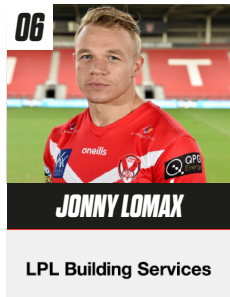
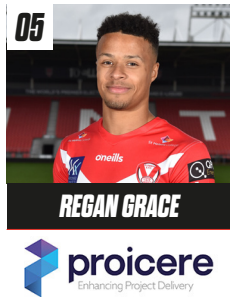
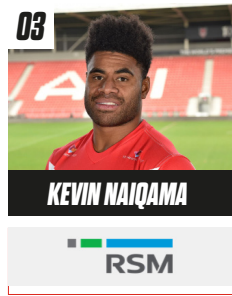
